AWANA Organization Rules

2016 - 2017



ORGANIZATIONAL

1. AWANA'S fellowship meal starts at 5:30 pm. There is NO after school care at the church and children should not arrive before 5:30. There is no supervision for children before 5:30 pm.
2. AWANA dues are 50 cents per child, per week. The total for the 2016-2017 year will be \$16.00.
3. Absolutely no cell phones visible or ringing during AWANA. They will be taken up, given to Commander Brown, and he will keep them until AWANA is over and then give them back to you when you leave.
4. No playing in any parking lot, especially the front one. No going into the sanctuary before AWANA.
5. Outside play area is the swing area between the two building and inside the gym. Do not play on the parking lot and no running in and out of the building.
6. Please watch your muddy feet. Wipe them off before entering the building.
7. There will be no hitting, pushing, shoving, or throwing things at people.
8. There will be NO name calling or being ugly towards other AWANA clubbers (all kids are your friends and brothers and sisters in Christ). Bad language will be given a 1 count and will be reported to Commander Brown. If it continues, Commander Brown will call your parents.
9. Sign up with Commander Brown for the pledges. Uniforms must be worn to hold a flag or a Bible. You may not borrow a uniform from the office or a friend, you must bring your own uniform.
10. No cold drinks may be purchased from the drink machine until after all the clubbers are dismissed at the end of the night and drinks should NOT be bought with your dues money. DO NOT open drinks in the gym.
11. Respect should be given to all the buildings that we use. No writing on the walls, or chairs. Remember to clean up after yourself when you go to the restrooms.
12. NO one is to go upstairs until class time begins (for AWANA clubbers that is girls' grades 5-6 only).
13. Each clubber should obey ALL leaders at all times even if they are not your class leaders.

MEAL TIME

1. AWANA is a ministry to the community; please help us to continue to provide meals by helping with a donation of \$2.00 per person or no more than \$8.00 per family.
2. Please allow the leaders to eat first so they may prepare for your classes.
3. Do not get more than you will eat and only one dessert per child.
4. When you are finished eating, you MUST put your dishes and drink cups in the trash.
5. Please eat before you go to play.
6. NO food or drink in the hallways please.
7. Do not take cups outside or leave trash on the grounds.
8. Listen for the whistle and line up to go to your classes quietly and orderly.

CLASS TIME

1. Your focus should be on God.
2. Girls please leave your purses and belongings closed during all classes.
3. Going to all classes is mandatory. You may not go to the office to get out of any class.
4. If you are sick, tell your director and they will get you to the office and then you will be allowed to call your parents to come pick you up.
5. T&T clubbers and Sparks may place your back packs or any carry items, in your rooms before class begins.

HANDBOOK TIME

1. Work on handbook verses and NO talking. Study quietly.
2. Each clubber should wait for their turn to say verses quietly with no talking so that others may study.
3. Sections for the first semester will be totaled to earn a “**Christmas Family Movie Night**”. Sections will be totaled to earn a “**Surprise Blow-Out Party**” at the end of the year.

GAME TIME

1. Go to the gym for game time and sit down on the lines immediately with no rough housing.
2. You must listen to Game Director for instructions.
3. If you do not follow the rules, you WILL be asked to sit out on the sidelines and watch.
4. Please wear tennis shoes (flip flops or socks are too slippery on cement floor).

CLOSING CEREMONY

1. Each class should sit down on sidelines with their group and come to attention and be quiet when the whistle is blown.
2. Respect should be shown for each class' award time and you should be quiet when any director is speaking.
3. Please stay in the gym until your name is called on the loud speaker to meet your parents outside.
4. Do not leave your handout papers in the gym; they are to go home to your parents for their information about what you are doing in AWANA.

DISCIPLINE:

1. A 5 count is the primary way leaders keep order in a group. The Director in charge will count to 5 loudly and slowly. All Clubbers are to be quiet and still by the end of the count 5. Any Clubbers not quiet at the end of the 5 count is in danger of receiving a “personal infraction”.
2. A 1, 2, 3 Count is used for “personal infractions” on an individual clubber. It is continued through the night among all classes. If a clubber receives 3 personal infraction counts, he/she then goes to the Commander and they will visit about the infractions and proper behavior. The Commander then has the prerogative of calling the parents to come get their clubber for the remainder of the evening. The personal count starts over each week.
