

Bosqueville, A Great Place to Live!

The Bosqueville Community is an unincorporated area located between Waco and China Spring. Three school districts are nearby; just down the road from the Church is Bosqueville ISD; 12 miles north west is China Spring ISD, and Waco ISD just five miles south. There is not an actual town of Bosqueville, but rather a community that is broad and encompasses parts of three nearby communities. Living in Bosqueville gives you access to anything Waco in less than 10 minutes.

Presently there is much growth happening in the Bosqueville and China Spring areas, with many families seeking the school districts and a more relaxed way of life. Many young families live near our Church campus representing all ethnic groups. Most people commute to Waco for work.

McLennan Community College, Texas State Technical College, and Baylor University are located within a 10-to-15-minute drive from the Church. All of these educational opportunities from elementary schools to college, makes the Bosqueville/China Spring area an inviting place to live and raise a family.

These communities have a feel of togetherness and friendliness that was established years ago through the churches. There is a great need for ministry to the people of this area. Though we are classified as a small church, having 75 members, 59% of those attend four times a month. Even though most of our members are over the age of 55, the nucleus of our Church body is active and agree there is great potential for growth.
